What is the Global UGRAD program?

The Global UGRAD Program is a U.S. Department of State sponsored initiative that grants scholarships to undergraduate level students from over 55 countries. Students are placed at colleges and universities across the United States where they participate in one semester of undergraduate, non-degree study. Global UGRAD is administered by World Learning.

Since 2008, World Learning has facilitated the placement of almost 1,800 Global UGRAD students. Students leave the U.S. with the tools to become leaders in their professions and home communities.

What is covered by the Global UGRAD program?

- International travel
- Tuition at host university
- Room and board
- Accident/sickness medical coverage
- Monthly stipend
- Funding for text books



Do you qualify to become a Global UGRAD participant?

You qualify if you are:

- an emerging student leader
- a current university student
- over 18 years of age
- in good academic standing at your home institution
- eligible to receive and maintain the U.S. student exchange visa (J-1)

What will you do during the Global UGRAD Program?

Students are actively engaged on and off campus, participating in community service, campus clubs and events, and various skill-building workshops.



Global UGRAD allows you to explore the

diversity of the U.S. and to share your culture with others. As an ambassador of your home country, you will have the opportunity to work towards cultivating mutual understanding.

What accommodations can you expect as a Global UGRAD?

- On-campus housing, with U.S. student roommates, and options for single-gender living and substance-free living spaces
- Access to comprehensive meal plans with provisions for special diets
- High-quality academic programs that match your interests and needs
- English language support, if necessary


